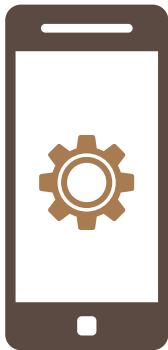

## How to Enable AOL 2-Step Verification



- Sign into your account
- Under "2-Factor Authentication", click "Set up" in the right-hand column
- On the screen that opens, enter the number where you'd like to receive sign-in codes by Text or Voice call
- Click Call me or Text me to get a code to verify your number



- You will receive a text or call with your security code



- Enter the verification code. Click Verify
- Your Disable code is displayed. Important: Print, copy and paste, or write down and save this code.
- This is what you'll use in case you lose or can't get to your phone. Keep it in a safe place you can easily get to later
- After you save your Disable code, click OK, I saved this
- Click Turn on. You activated 2-Factor Authentication.

If you access your AOL account using any non-AOL apps or other programs (such as Mail on a mobile phone or in Outlook), complete the final step of creating application-specific passwords
